

2016-2017 Gifted Referral and Eligibility Process Chart

Step 1

Automatic Referral

Students in grades (K-10) who score $\geq 90\%$ RT (Reading Total) **or** $\geq 90\%$ MT (Math Total) on the nationally norm-referenced test **Northwest Evaluation Association Measures of Academic Progress (MAP)** during the August 15 – September 13 testing window.



Step 2

SIS: Automated Processing System (1 of 3)

Automated processing system uniformly considers information collected on MAP. The system determines if it is appropriate to proceed with formal evaluation.



Additional evaluation is not needed. Student continues in regular education programs.



Step 3

Formal Evaluation

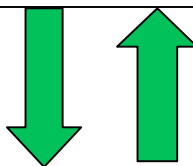
Student is referred for gifted education evaluation in mental ability (CogAT), creativity and motivation (Renzulli).



Step 4

SIS: Automated Processing System (2 of 3)

Automated processing system uniformly considers information collected from **formal evaluation**. Reviews assessment results and makes recommendation.



Step 5

Eligible

Qualifies in three out of the four areas



Schedule student to receive gifted services

Needing Step II (3 of 3)

Students who score at the specified levels on nationally norm-referenced tests (CogAT) and/or (MAP) - **Assessed in the areas of Creativity and/or Motivation (Alternative Assessments) only**



Not Eligible

Qualified with less than three out of the four areas



Student continues existing schedule
