



DCSD 7-Year Enrollment Forecast Fall 2019 Summary

### 1. District Enrollment

Enrollment in the DeKalb County School District is expected to decrease by close to 500 students from Fall 2018 to Fall 2019.

### 2. Enrollment by Grade Level

**ES** - Elementary school enrollment is expected to have a large decline, with a decrease of nearly 800 students. This is a continuation of a trend that began in 2016 and is driven largely by smaller incoming kindergarten classes.

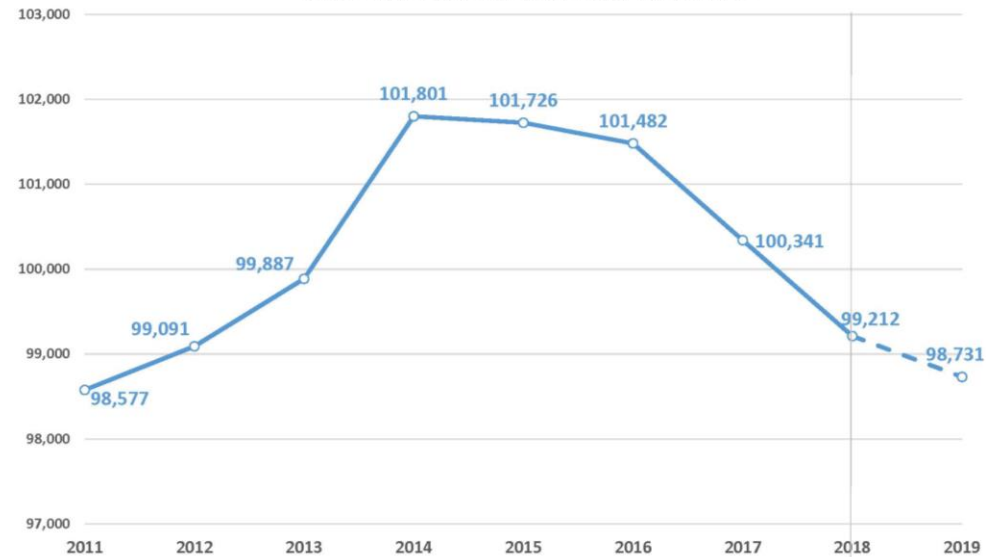
**MS** - Middle school enrollment is expected to increase by almost 450 students. This is due to a smaller 8th grade cohort matriculating out of middle schools into 9th grade in Fall 2019.

**HS** - High school enrollment is expected to decrease by nearly 400 students. This is due to both a smaller 8th grade cohort matriculating into 9th grade in Fall 2019, and a large 12th grade graduating out of DCSD schools and being replaced by a smaller 11th grade.

### 3. Neighborhood School Enrollment by Region

- Region 1 is expected to increase by around 300 students.
- Region 2 is expected to decrease slightly by around 100 students.
- Region 3 is expected to decrease by 270 students.
- Region 4 is expected to decrease slightly by 75 students.
- Region 5 is expected to decrease by around 250 students.
- Region 6 is expected to decrease by around 175 students.
- Region 7 is expected to be very close to current enrollment.
