



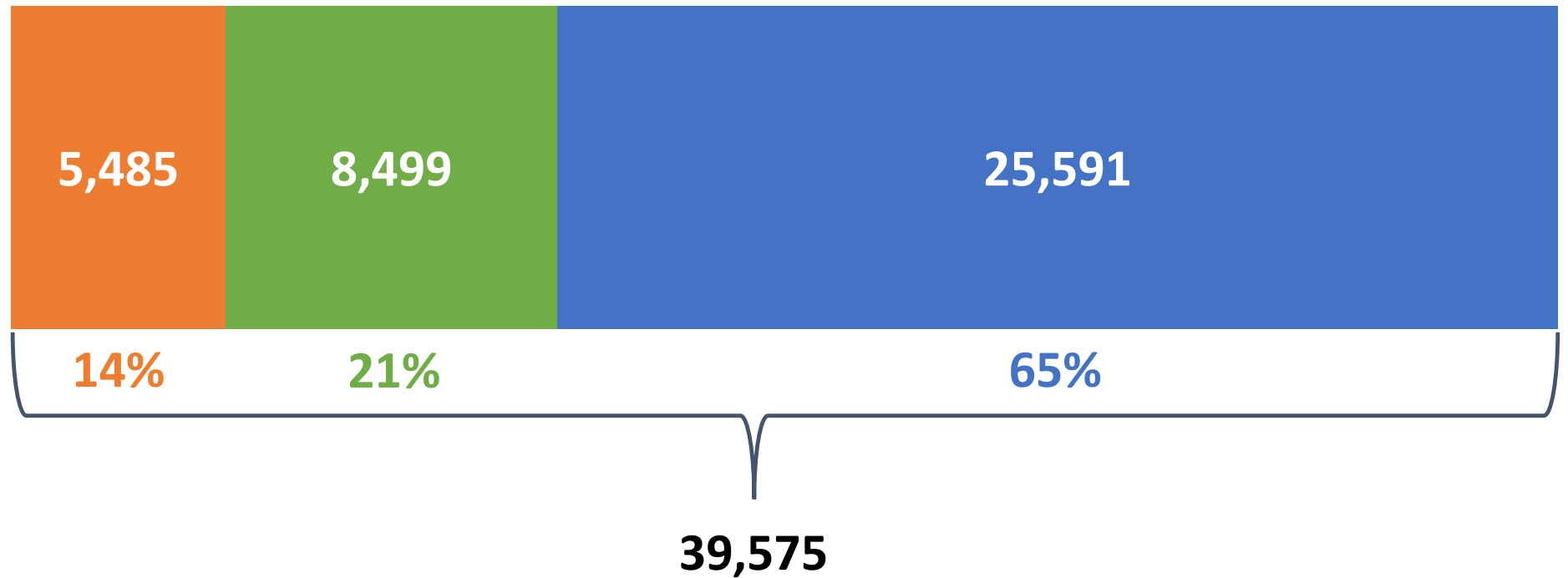

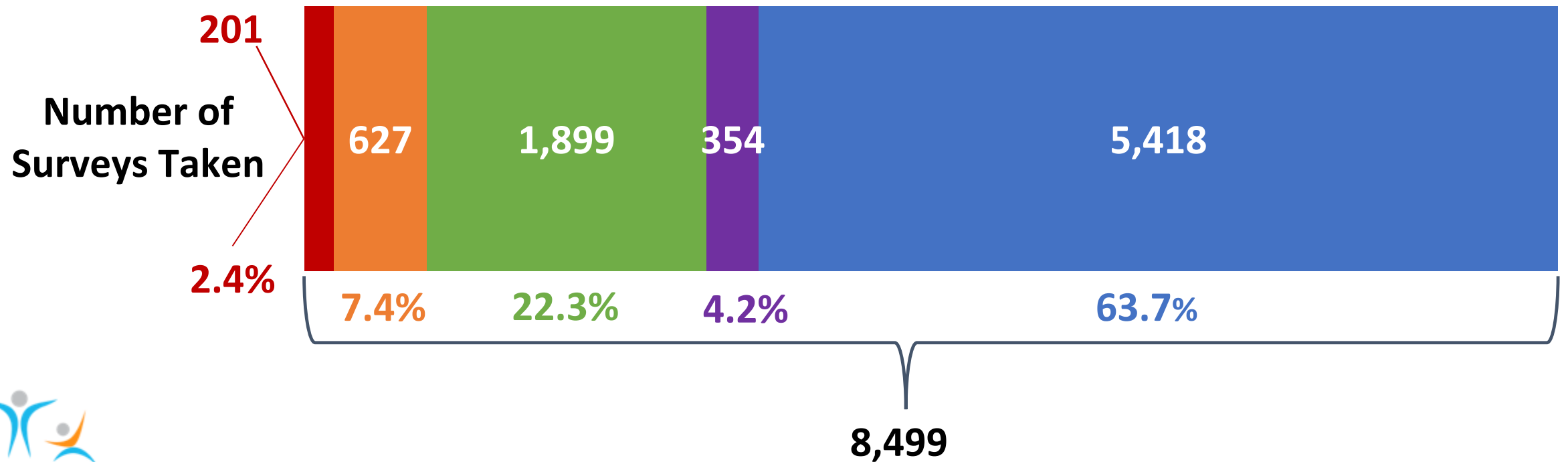

Number of Surveys Taken



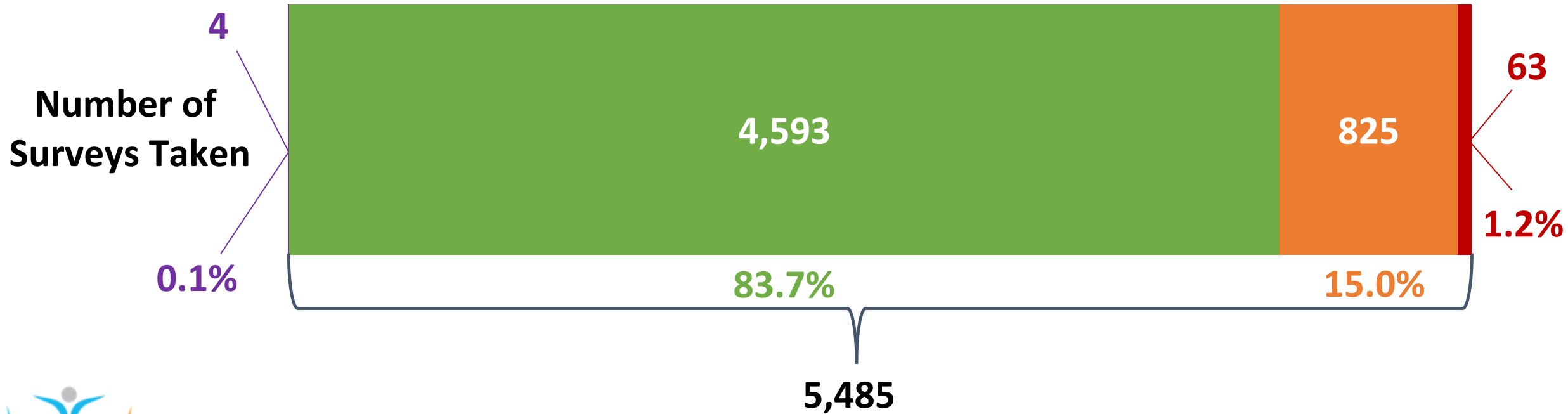

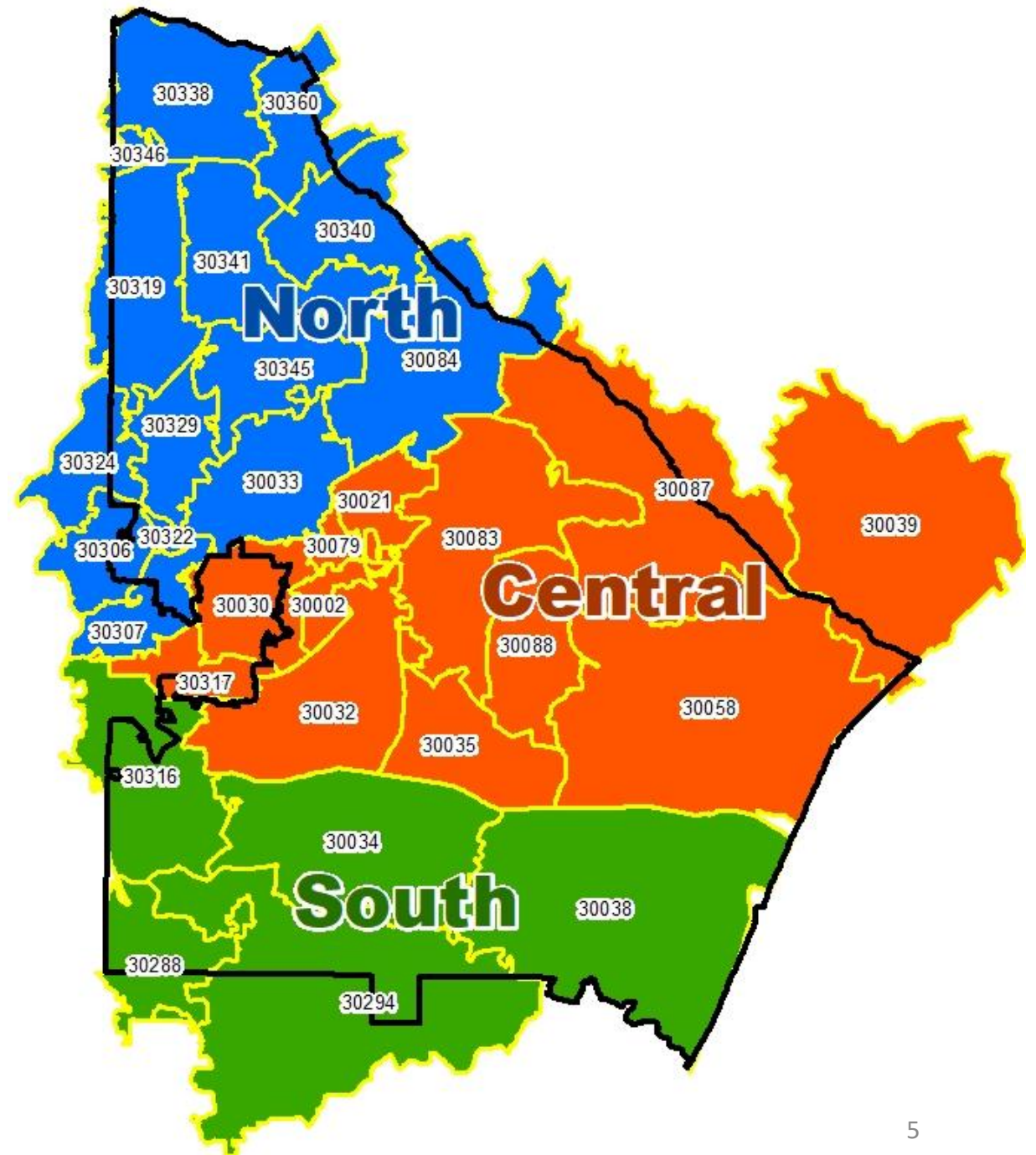

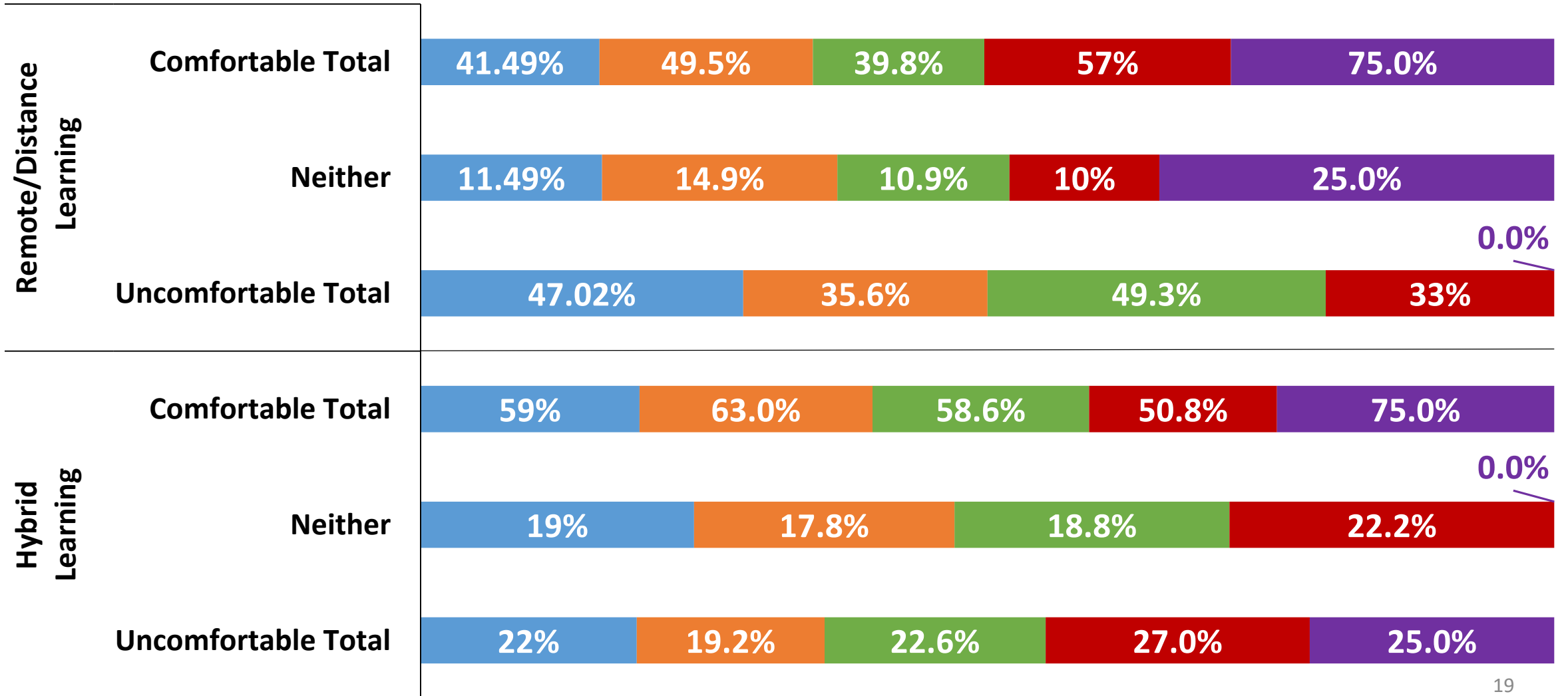

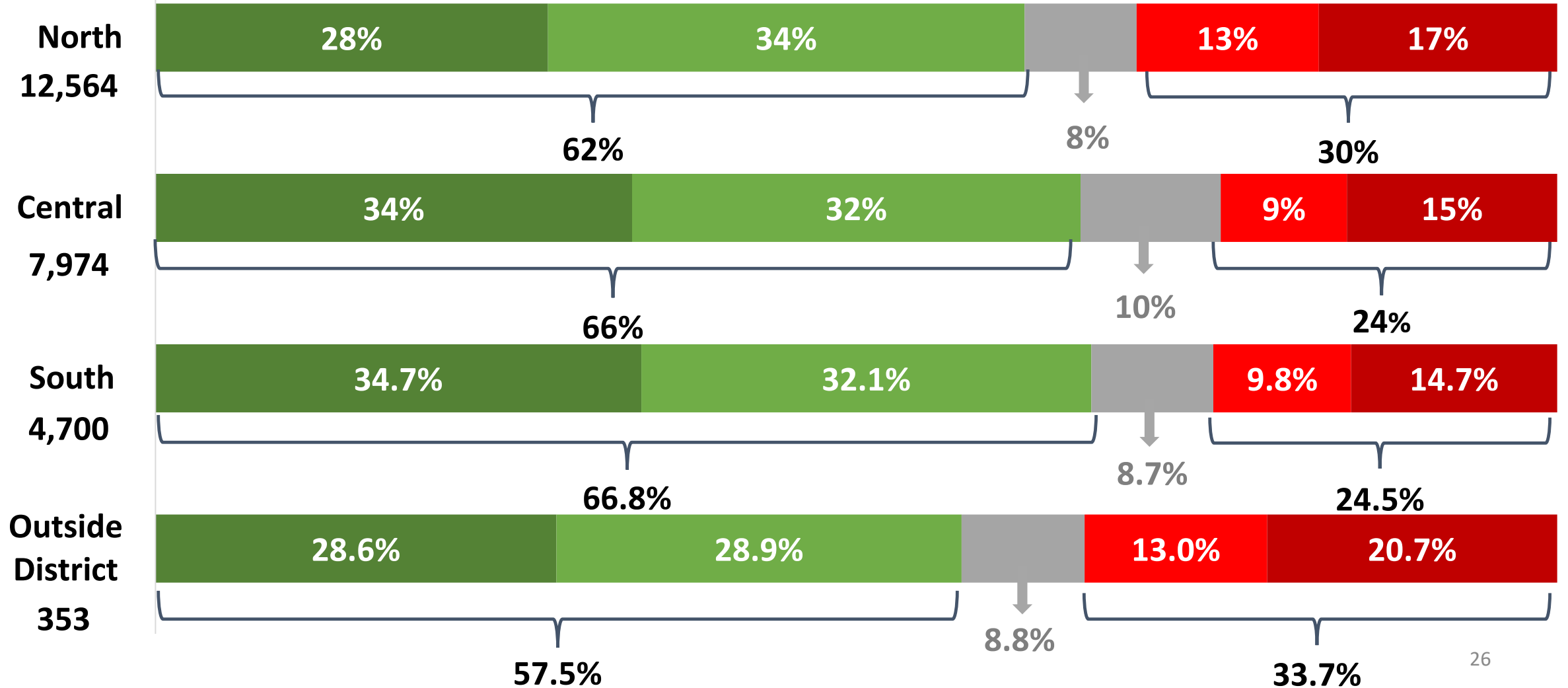

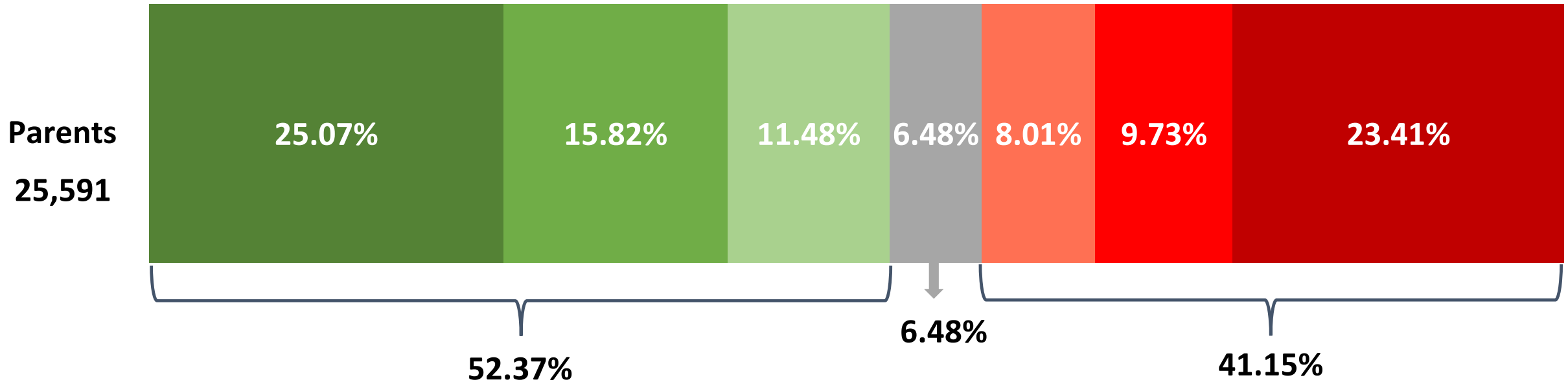

If the district offered a full-time Remote/Distance Learning school choice option, how likely would you choose this option?



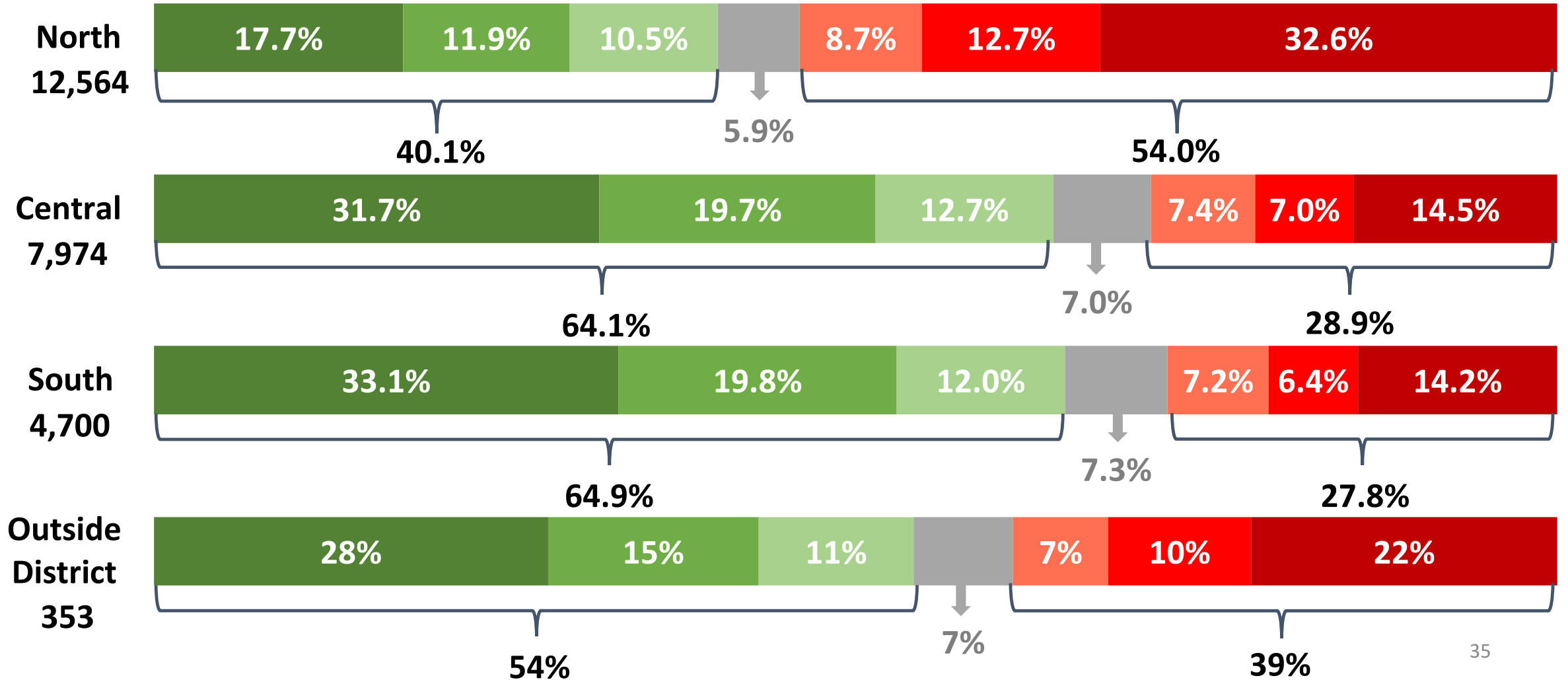

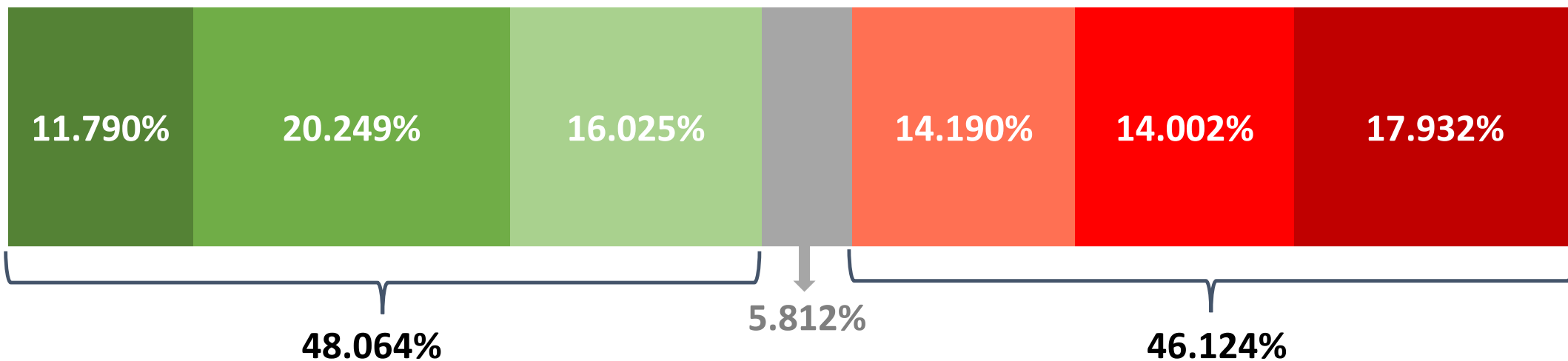

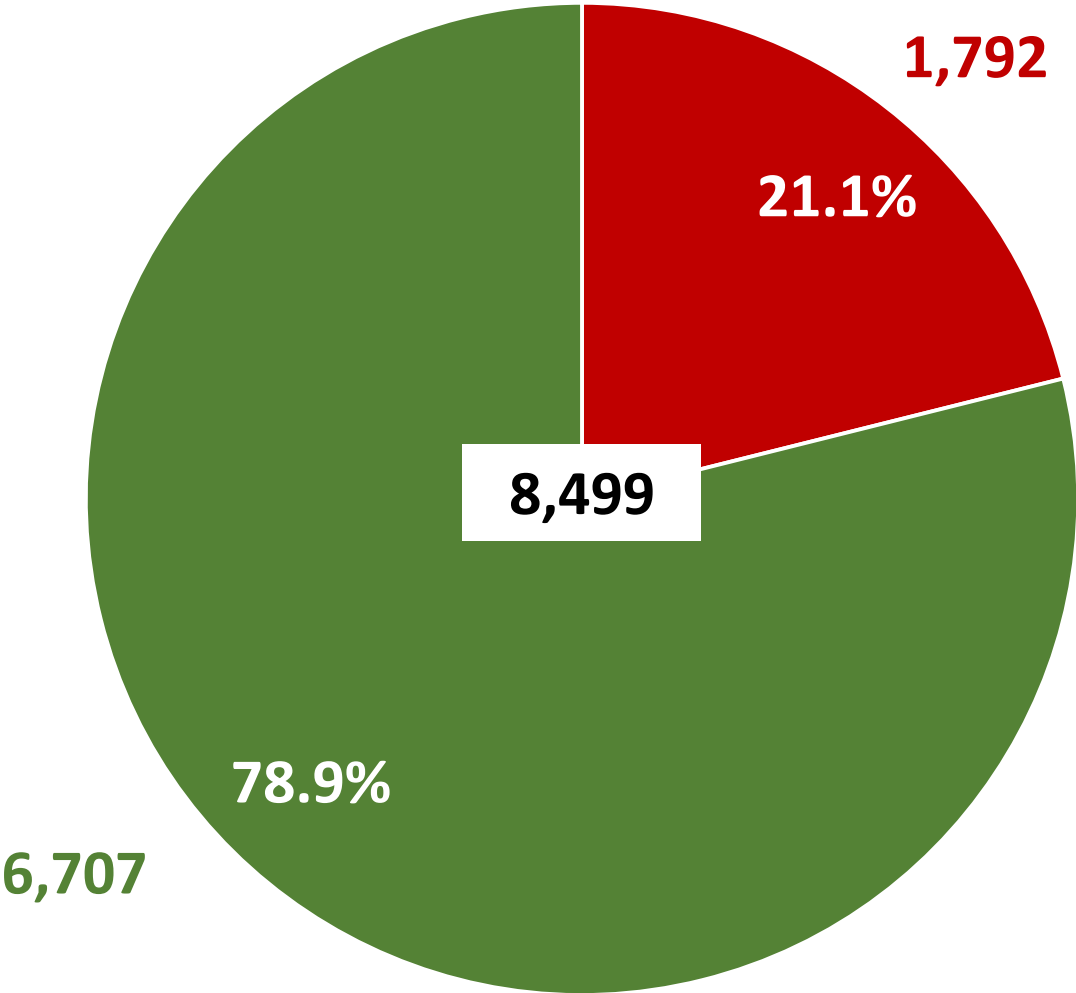

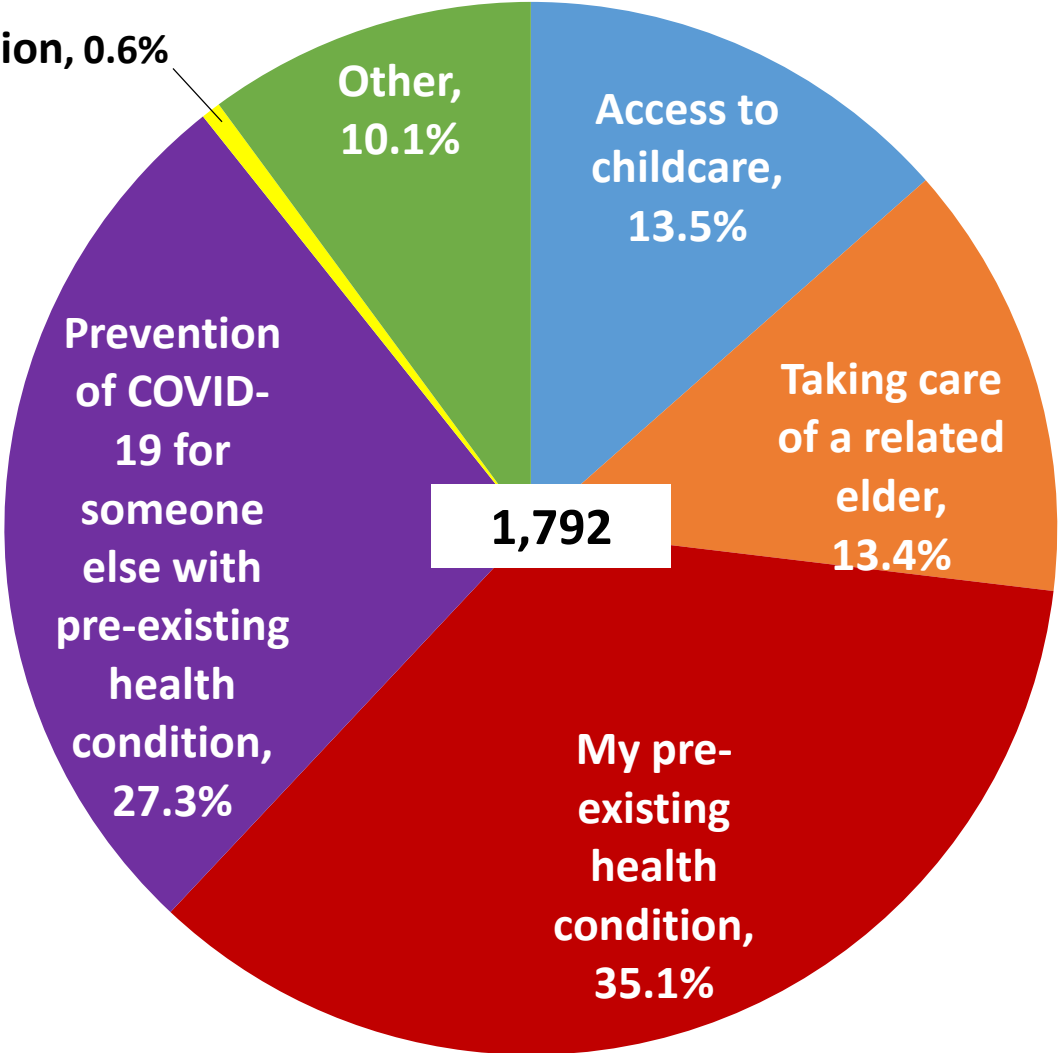

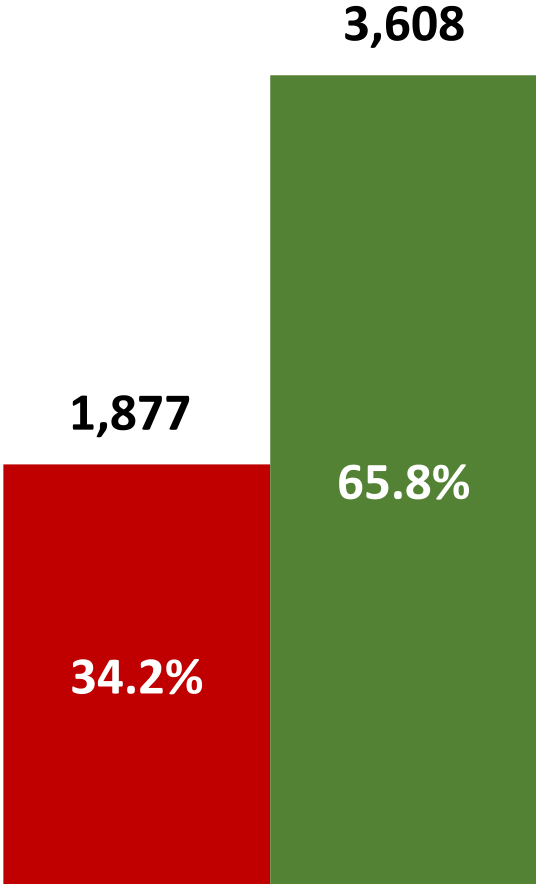

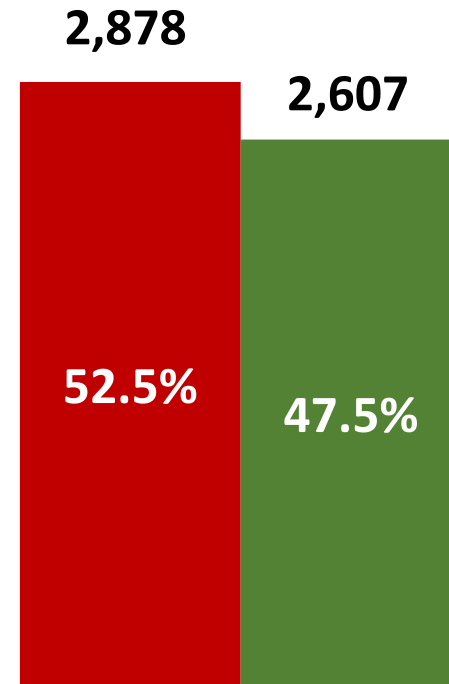

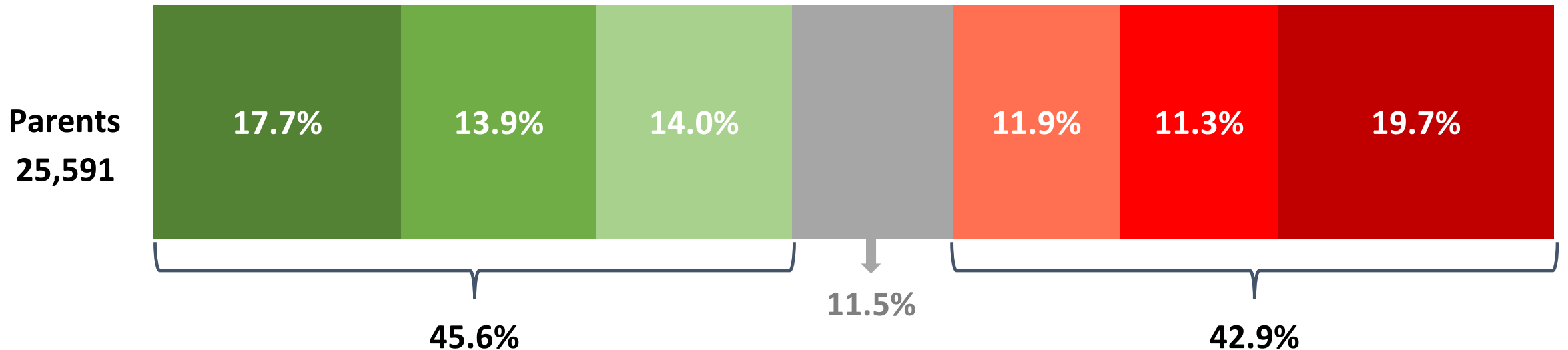
Do you have any concerns about the school's ability to enforce social distancing (staying six feet away from others) while at school?

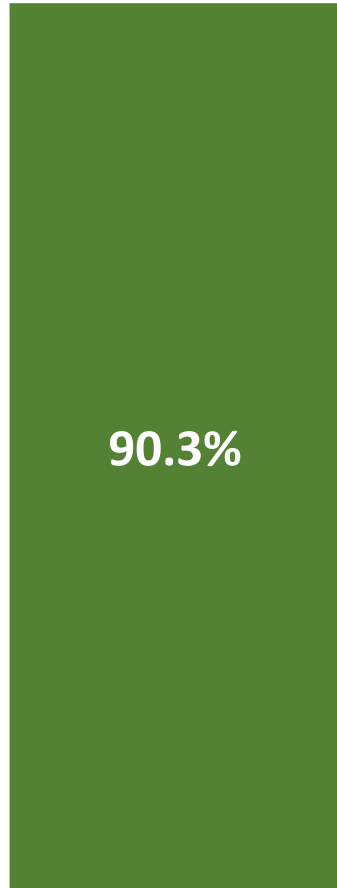

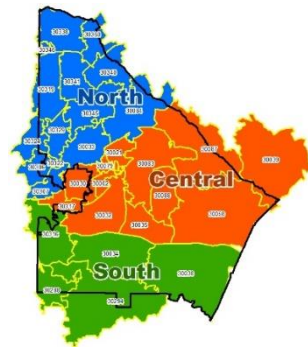

# Need Internet Access: Parents by Geographic Area



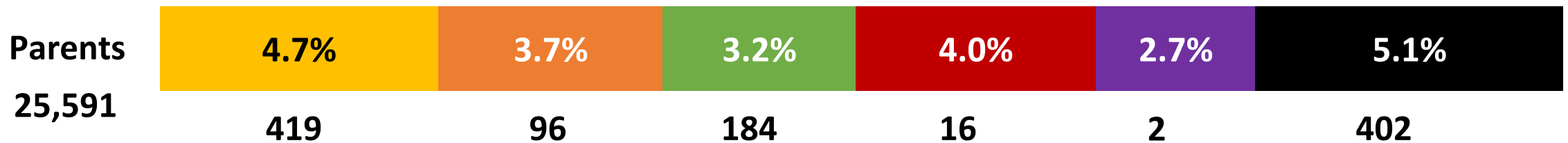

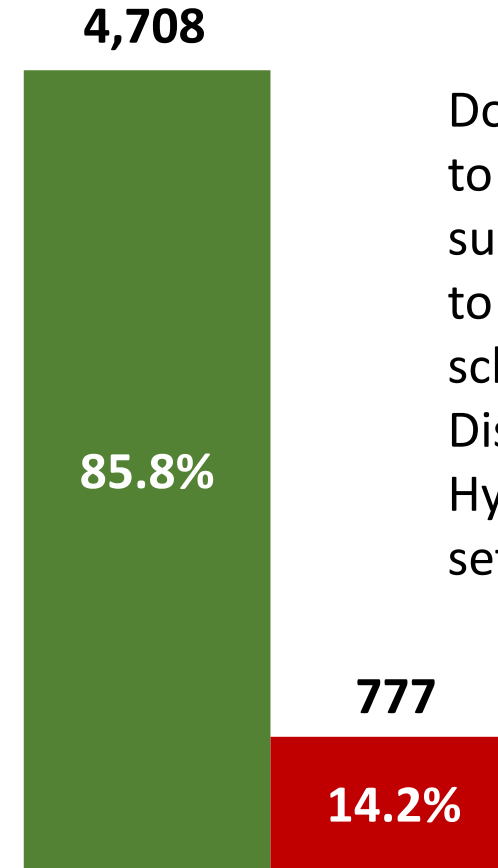

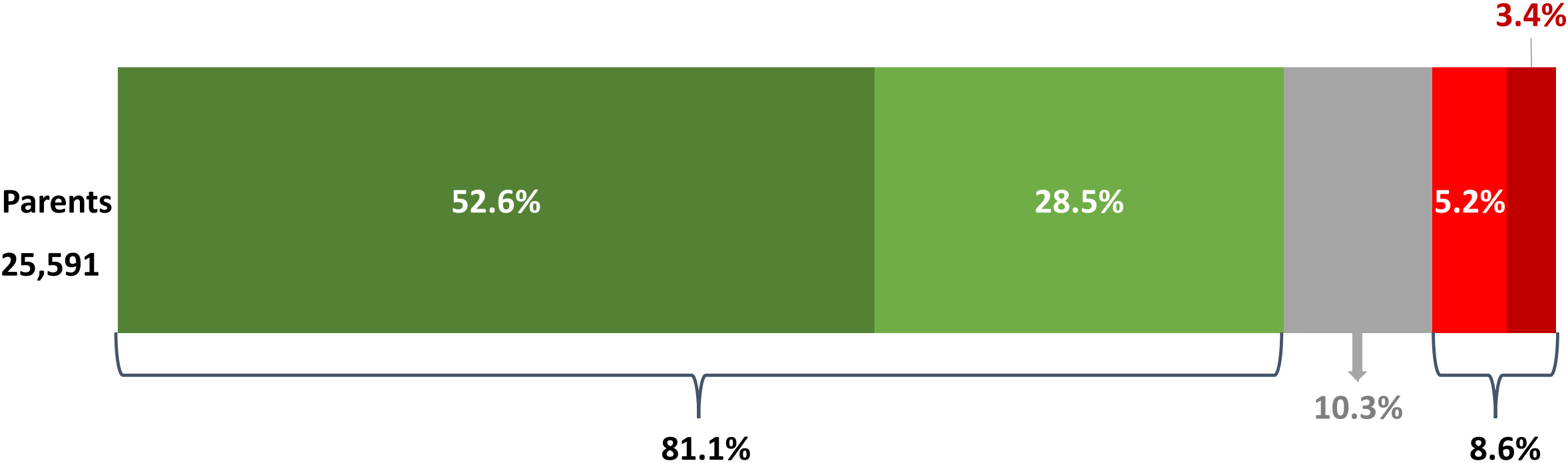

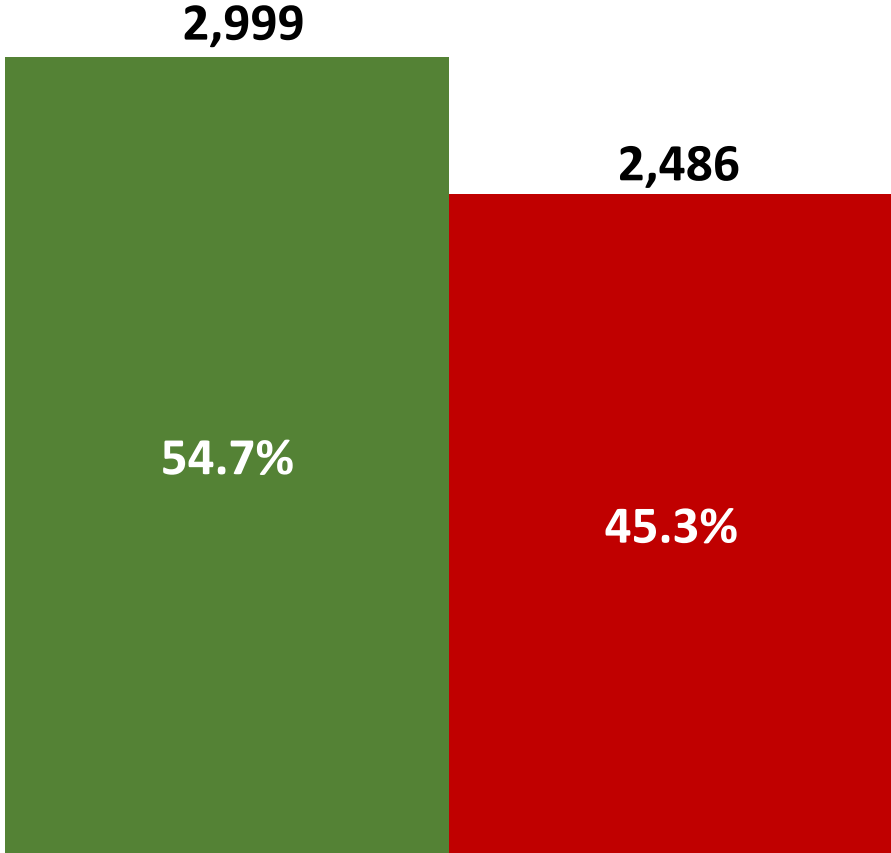

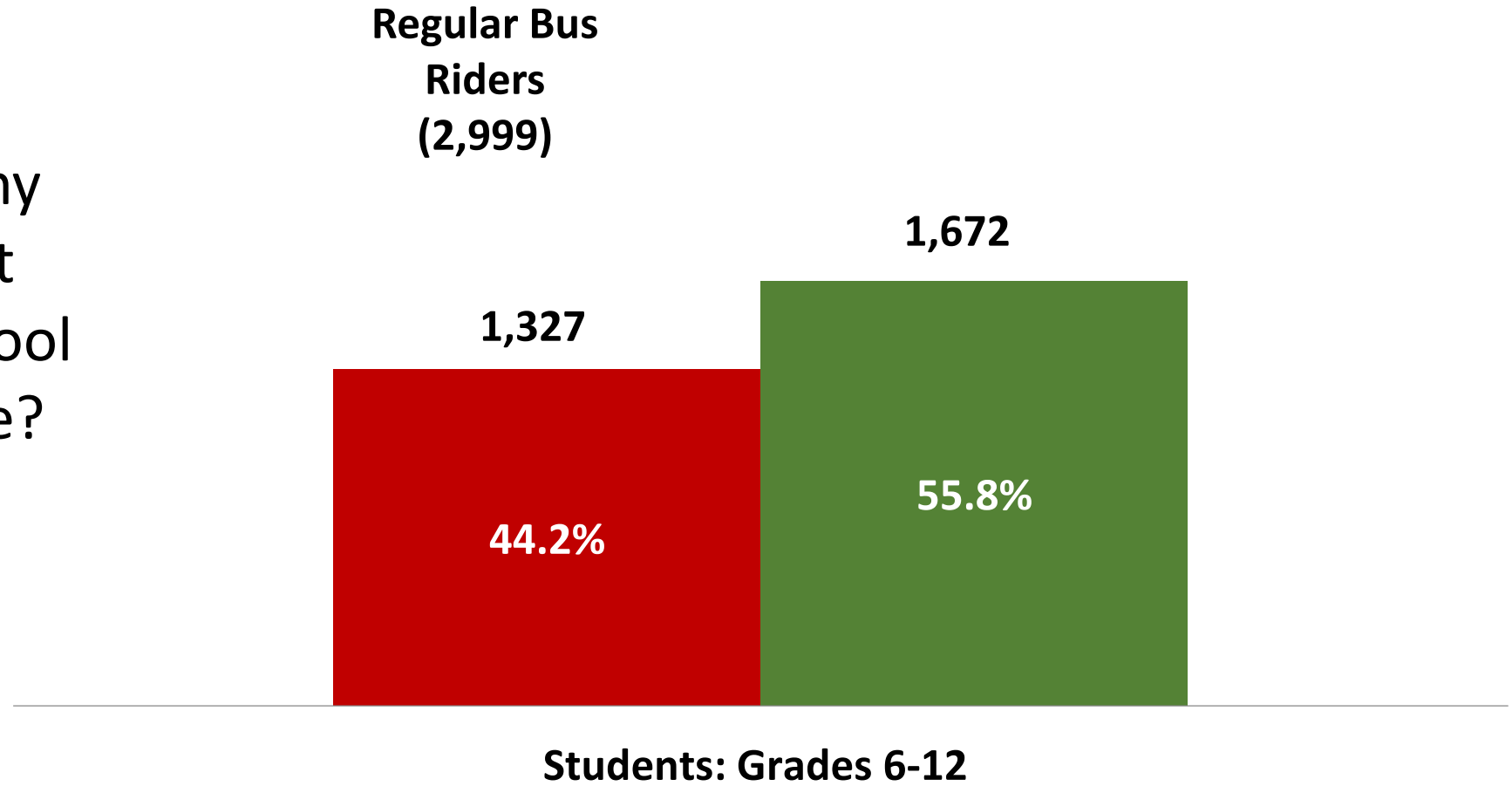

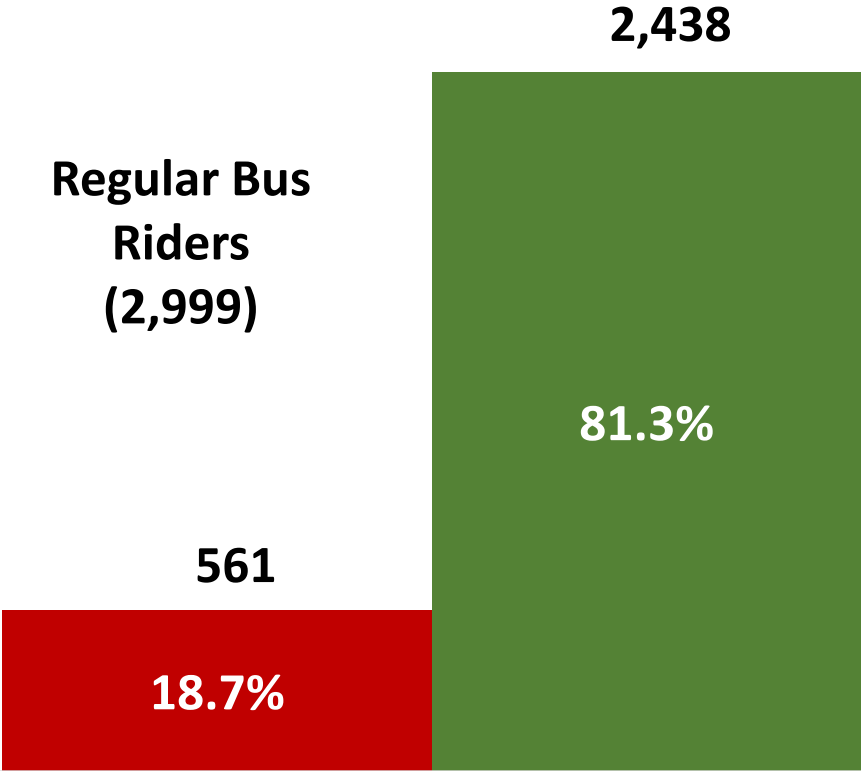

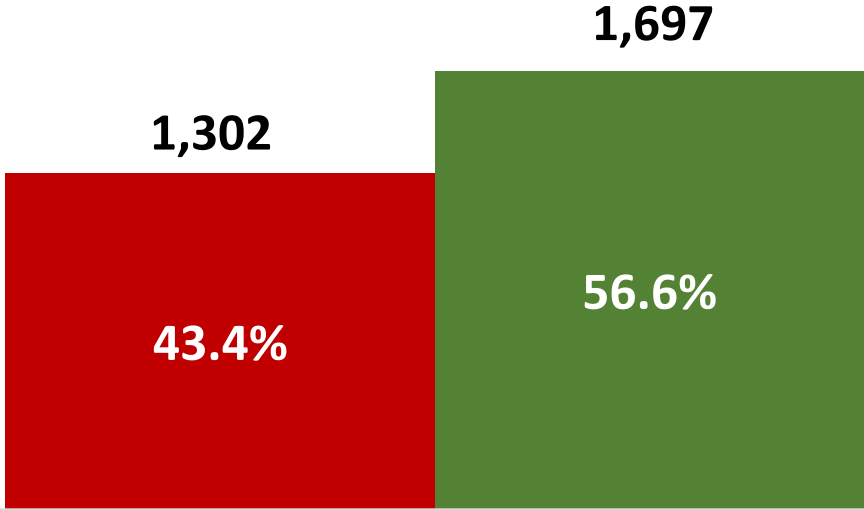

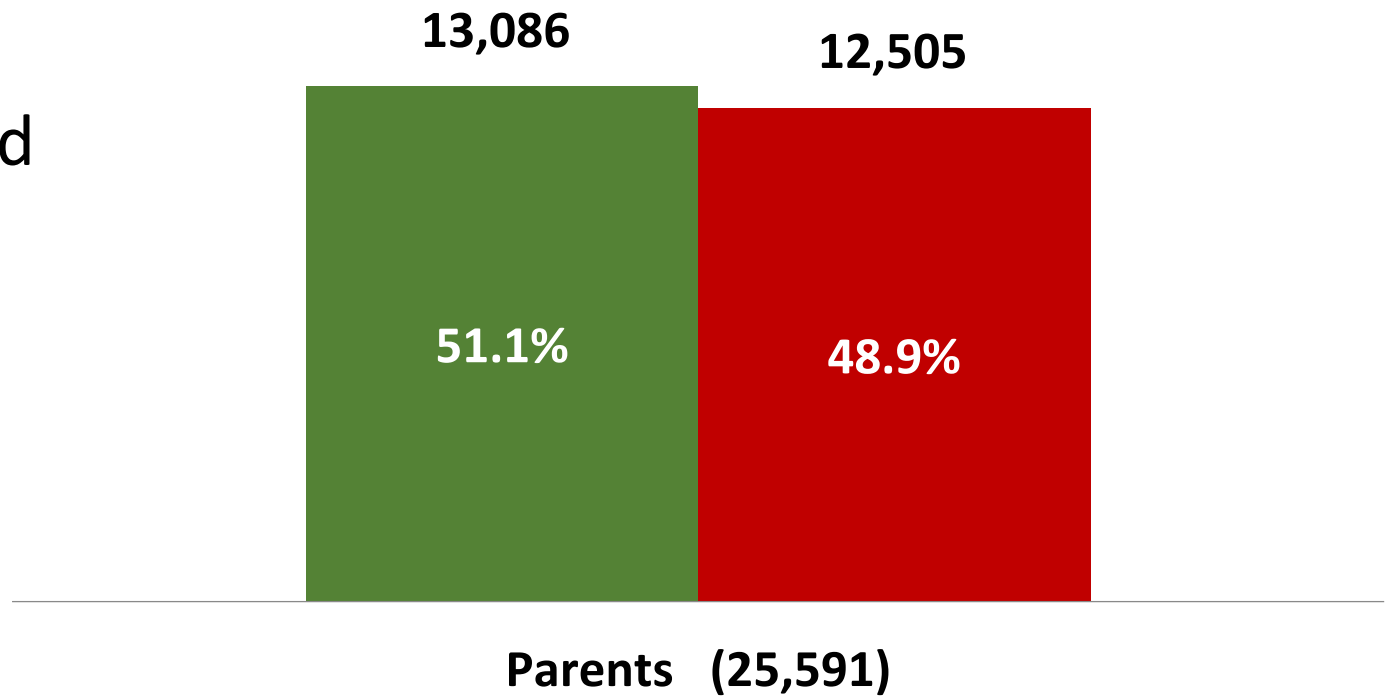

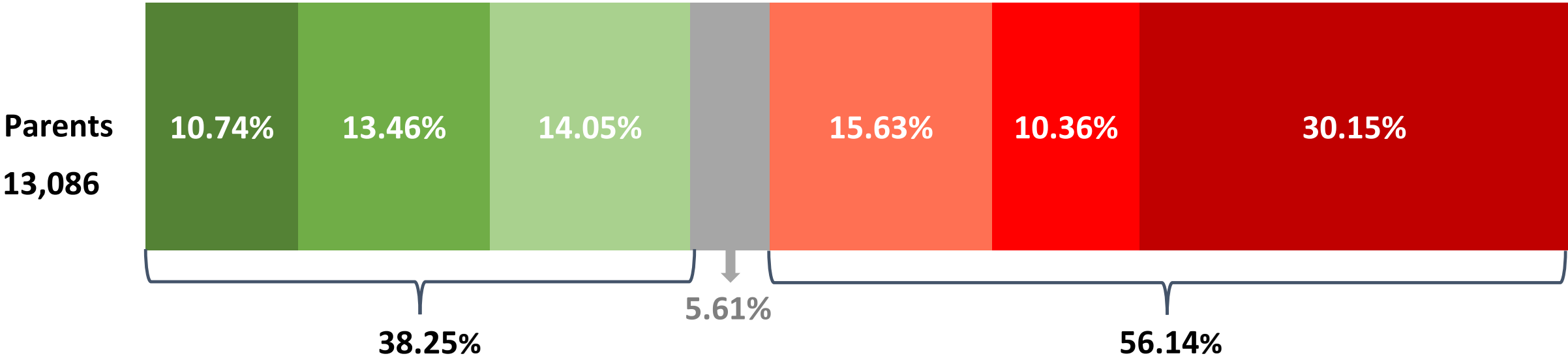

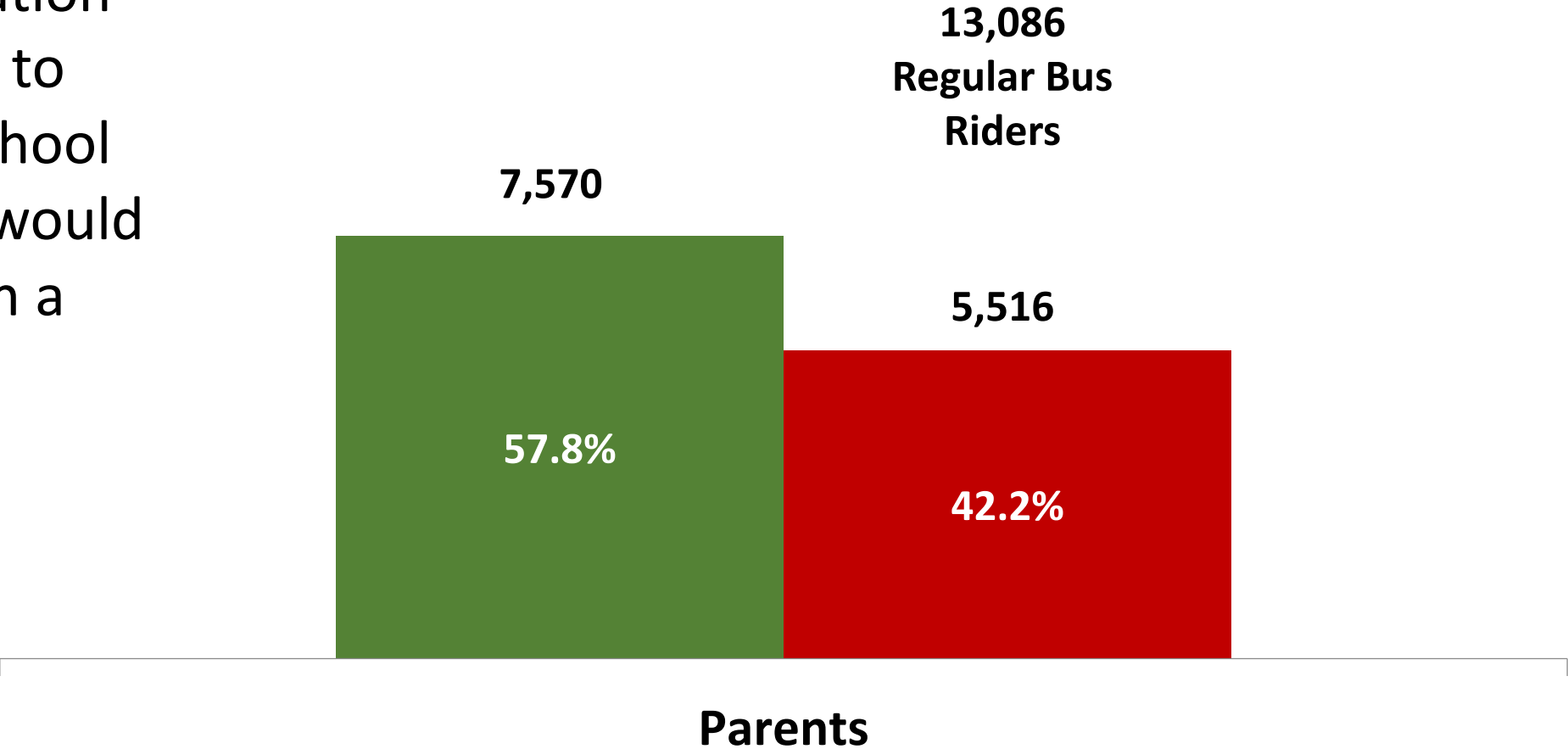


How comfortable do you feel allowing your child(ren) to ride on a bus to/from school at this time?

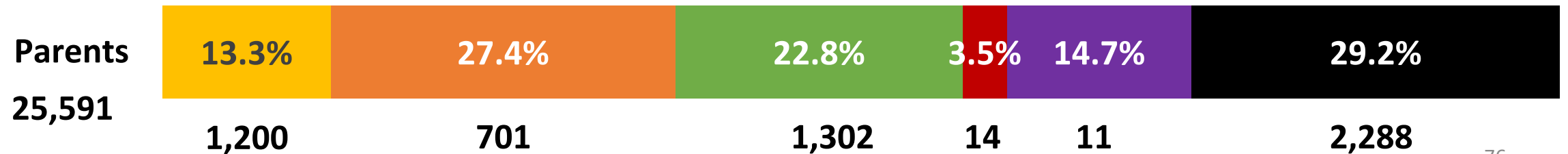

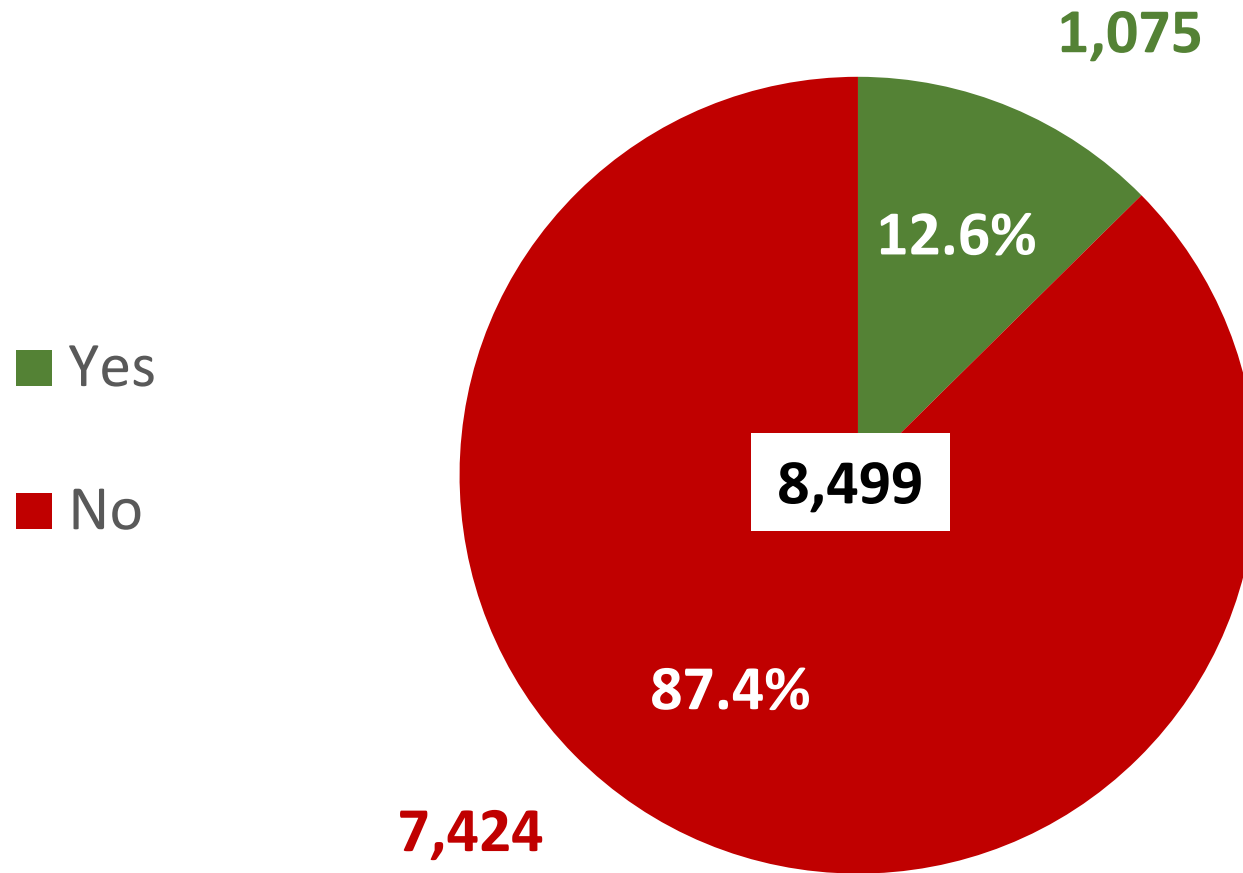

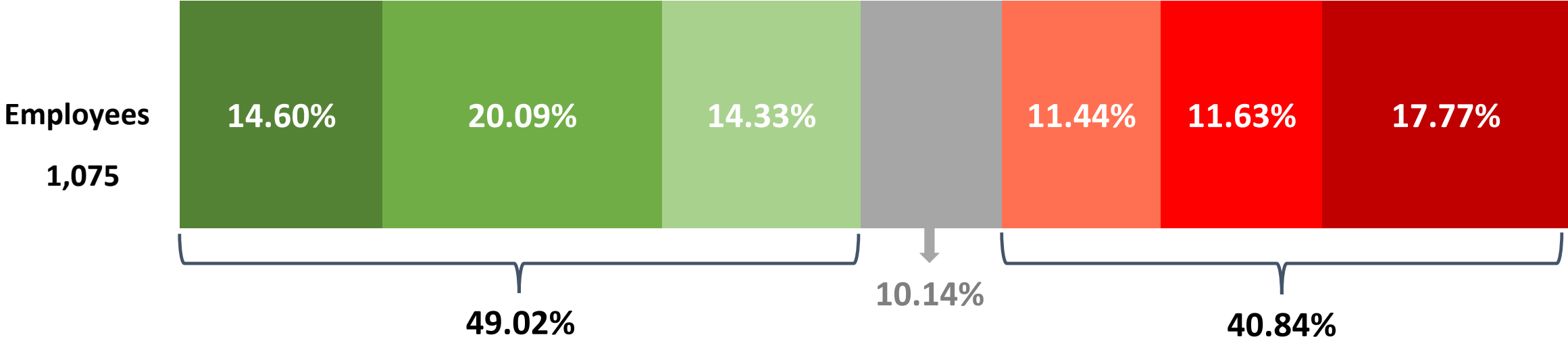
